Subj.: Current Tense Situation in the Region

Reference to our Safety Bulletin 01/2020 and based on the coordination outcomes with concerned ICAO MID Office, EUROCONTROL, IATA with the support from ICAO HQ and as per the CCT emails, please note that FAA relaxed the restrictions over the Gulf and Gulf of Oman, this will facilitate operations in/out from nearby airports.

All Kuwaiti Air Operator Certificate Holders operating to the above-mentioned Airspaces should:

- Continuously monitor the safety and security of operations along the mentioned routes/airways and airports;
- In order to ensure safe accommodation of changes and keeping the situation under control, **the Kuwait DGCA strongly requests our Air Operator Certificate holders to continuously conduct and provide their Risk Assessment and Plans for their operation of flights and the contingency procedures in advance in line with the organizational Safety Management Systems (SMS);**
- Monitor and apply the relevant NOTAMs pertaining to their intended flight;
- Ensure that the provision of Air Traffic Services is applied throughout the flight in compliance with International Standards.

ICAO Doc. 10084 may be used for the purpose of conducting Risk Assessment for flying over or near these zones.

This is passed for your urgent information and necessary action and we will keep you updated with further instruction when needed.
