Subj.: Airspace of Saudi Arabia - Jeddah Flight Information Region

The reason of this Safety Bulletin is to make the civilian air travel safe by the flights operated by Kuwaiti Air Operator Certificate holders and Private Operator Certificate holders, when flying into or over the Airspace of Saudi Arabia Airspace due to the conflict in Yemen is affected in the South part of Jeddah FIR.

Kindly refer the attached "Conflict Zone Information Bulletin" published by Europeean Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA).

All Kuwaiti AOC and POC holders operating to the above-mentioned airspace shall continuously monitor the security and safety of operations along the mentioned routes/airways and airports. Ensure that the provision of Air Traffic Services is applied throughout the flight in compliance with international standards. Also, monitor the NOTAMs pertaining to the flights specifically to the above-mentioned Airspace.

In order to ensure safe accommodation of changes and keeping the situation under control, the Kuwait DGCA strongly requests our AOC and POC holders to continuously conduct and provide their Risk Assessment and Plans for their operation of flights and the contingency procedures in advance in line with the organizational Safety Management Systems (SMS).

The Kuwait DGCA and our Air Navigation Services are also in close monitoring mode and we will inform when any further actions from our side or in cooperation with the EASA, ICAO EUR and MID offices. The Kuwait DGCA highly appreciates all our Operators continuous support.

From 10/05/2018 and until further notice, French air carriers are requested:

- To exercise caution during flight operations in the airspace of Saudi Arabia (FIR JEDDAH (OEJD)) and follow instructions given by the Saudi authorities providing air traffic services, particularly in the southwest of JEDDAH FIR (OEJD) in which SCATANA (Security Control of Air Traffic and Air Navigation Aids rules) may be activated by NOTAM from the Saudi authorities;
- Not to operate any flights to Abha (OEAB), Jazan (OEGN), Nejran (OENG), Sharurah (OESH), Wadi Al Dawasir (OEWD) and Bisha (OEBH) airports located in the southwest of JEDDAH FIR (OEJD) in which SCATANA (Security Control of Air Traffic and Air Navigation Aids rules) may be activated by NOTAM from the Saudi authorities. Such airports shall not be identified as alternate airports when planning flight operations.

PILOTS SHALL KEEP LISTENING TO THE APPROPRIATE ATC FREQUENCIES AND SHALL ADHERE STRICTLY TO ATC INSTRUCTIONS WHEN FLYING TO/FROM THE SOUTHERN AIRPORTS DUE TO DEFENSE RESPONSES THAT MAY OCCUR. IN ADDITION SAUDI ARABIA IS PUTTING IN PLACE MEASURES TO MITIGATE RISK THAT MIGHT RESULT FROM LIMITED LONG-RANGE MISSILES AND UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM CAPABILITIES THAT MAY TARGET AIRPORTS WITHIN JEDDAH FIR .
