The following limitation are consider to be essential in special flight permit.

- 1) The validity of Permit to Fly shall not exceed 14 days.
- 2) The Certificate shall only be issued to an aircraft that is to be flown under the authorisation of an DGCA Permit to Fly (Form 20) issued by the State of Kuwait.
- 3) The Certificate shall be issued in duplicate and one copy kept elsewhere than in the aircraft.
- 4) If the airworthiness condition of the aircraft is affected during the period of validity the Certificate shall re-issued.
- 5) Flight release certificate remains valid provided the declared configuration is applicable, the aircraft is maintained in accordance with defined instructions, and compliance with airworthiness directives is observed.
- 6) a copy of the permit should be on board the aircraft at all times when operating under the terms of the permit;
- 7) the registration marks assigned to the aircraft by the State of Registry should be displayed on the aircraft in conformity with the requirements of that State;
- 8) persons or property should not be carried for compensation or hire;
- 9) no person should be carried in the aircraft unless that person is essential to the purpose of the flight and has been advised of the contents of the authorization and the airworthiness status of the aircraft;
- 10) the aircraft should be operated only by crew who are aware of the purpose of the flight and any limitations imposed, and who hold appropriate certificate or licenses acceptable to the Kuwait DGCA;
- 11) all flight should be conducted so as to avoid areas where flight might create hazardous exposure to persons or property;
- 12) all flight should be conducted within the performance operating limitations prescribed in the aircraft flight manual and any additional limitation specified by the Kuwait DGCA for the particular flight; and
- 13) Non commercial flight only.
