KCASR 7 -Aircraft Registration and Cancellation

- (1) a written request for cancellation of the certificate specifying the State to which the aircraft will be registered in along with the original Certificate of Registration issued to the holder.
- (2) evidence satisfactory to the Kuwait DGCA that each holder of recorded right has been satisfied or has consented to the transfer.
- (b) The certificate of deregistration in wording and arrangement, shall be a replica of the certificate shown in Appendix II.
- (c) The certificate of registration shall be issued in English Language.
- (b)(d) The Kuwait DGCA shall notify the State to which the aircraft is to be registered in of the cancellation of registration by proper means as soon as all the requirements are satisfied.

7.13 Register of nationality, common and registration marks

- 7.13.1 The Kuwait DGCA shall maintain a current register showing for each aircraft registered in the State of Kuwait, the information recorded in the certificate of registration (see KCASR 7 Aircraft Registration and Cancellation, Subpart B Registration Application and Cancellation paragraph 7.7) paragraph 7.15). The register of unmanned free balloons shall contain the date, time and location of release, the type of balloon and the name of the operator.
- 7.13.2 If Kuwait DGCA issues a certificate of deregistration, it shall issue the certificate in accordance with paragraph 7.12.

7.14 Fees

The fees for applications under this KCASR 7 Aircraft Registration and Cancellation are as detailed in applicable part of KCASR 27 (Fees and Charges Regulation)

Subpart D - Marking

7.17 Nationality common and registration marks.

- (a) The nationality or common mark, and registration mark shall consist of a group of characters.
- (b) The nationality or common mark (9K) shall precede the registration mark.
- (c) The common mark shall be selected from the series of symbols included in the radio call signs allocated to the International Civil Aviation Organization by the International Telecommunication Union applicable to the State of Kuwait.
- (d) The nationality mark shall be selected from the series of nationality symbols included in the radio call signs allocated to the State of Registry by the International Telecommunication Union. The nationality mark shall be notified to the International Civil Aviation Organization.
 - **Note 1.** Assignment of the common mark to a common mark registering authority will be made by the International Civil Aviation Organization.
 - <u>Note 2.</u> Nationality marks and national emblems notified by states to ICAO and marks allocated by ICAO can be found in the list of aircraft nationality marks, National Emblems and Common Marks, which is published on the ICAO public website
- (e) The registration mark shall be letters, numbers, or a combination of letters and numbers, and shall be that assigned by the State of Registry or common mark registering authority.
- (f) When letters are used for the registration mark, combinations shall not be used which might be confused with the five-letter combinations used in the International Code of Signals, Part II, the three-letter combinations beginning with Q used in the Q Code, and with the distress signal SOS, or other similar urgent signals, for example XXX, PAN and TTT.
 - **Note.** For reference to these codes, see the currently effective International Telecommunications Regulations.
- (g) No person shall operate a State of Kuwait registered aircraft unless that aircraft displays State of Kuwait nationality and registration marks in accordance with the requirements of this Subpart D.
- (h) Unless otherwise authorized by the Kuwait DGCA, no person shall place on any aircraft a design, mark, or symbol which modifies, alters, or confuses the nationality and registration marks.
- (i) The nationality mark of the aircraft shall be "9K" and the registration marks shall be a group of three capital letters in Roman characters assigned by the Kuwait DGCA. The markings shall be without ornamentation, and a hyphen shall be placed between the nationality mark and registration marks. The nationality and registration marks shall be painted on the aircraft or shall be affixed there to by any other means ensuring a similar degree of permanence in the manner described in this Subpart D.

7.22 Width and spacing of marks (fixed wing aircraft and rotorcraft)

- (a) The width of each character (except the letter 'I' and the number '1') and the length of the hyphen between the nationality marks and registration mark shall be 2/3rd of the height of the character.
- (b) The letters and hyphen shall be formed by solid lines and shall be of a colour clearly contrasting with the background on which they appear. The thickness of the lines shall be 1/6th of the height of a letter.
- (c) Each letter shall be separate from the letter which it immediately proceeds or follows by a space equal to half the width of a letter. A hyphen shall be regarded as a letter for this purpose.

7.23 Display of nationality and registration marks (fixed wing aircraft and rotorcraft)

- (a) In addition to paragraph 7.41 of this KCASR 7 Aircraft Registration and Cancellation, the nationality and registration marks shall be inscribed, together with the name and address of the registered owner of the aircraft, on a fireproof metal plate affixed in a prominent position to the fuselage and near the main entrance to the aircraft.
- (b) Nationality and registration marks shall always be kept clean and visible.

7.24 Type of characters for nationality, common and registration marks

- (a) The letters shall be capital letters in Roman characters without ornamentation. Numbers shall be Arabic numbers without ornamentation.
- (b) The width of each character (except the letter I and the number 1) and the length of hyphens shall be two-thirds of the height of a character.
- (c) The characters and hyphens shall be formed by solid lines and shall be of a colour contrasting clearly with the background. The thickness of the lines shall be one-sixth of the height of a character.
- (d) Each character shall be separated from that which it immediately precedes or follows, by a space of not less than one-quarter of a character width. A hyphen shall be regarded as a character for this purpose.

7.25 Sale of aircraft and removal of markings

When an aircraft registered in the State of Kuwait is deregistered, the holder of the Certificate of Registration shall remove all State of Kuwait markings from the aircraft before its delivery to another state.

Subpart E - Identification Plate


7.26 Identification fireproof plate

- (a) An aircraft shall carry an identification plate inscribed with at least its nationality or common mark and registration mark.
- (b) The plate shall be made of fireproof metal or other fireproof material of suitable physical properties.
- (c) The plate shall be secured to the aircraft in a prominent position near the main entrance or, in the case of an unmanned free balloon, affixed conspicuously to the exterior of the payload and in the case of remotely piloted aircraft, secured in a prominent position near the main entrance or compartment or affixed conspicuously to the exterior of the aircraft if there is no main entrance or compartment.


